For S/HE Safe[™] certification (cost = \$1,000 USD):

- Evidence of:
 - Current employment as a martial arts instructor with acceptable employer OR
 - Instructor certification from acceptable organization
- Evidence of recent background check
- Review the curriculum and fill out evidence of completion following each module
- Pass written examination demonstrating mastery of curriculum

Continued certification (every two years) (cost = \$1,000 USD):
